 NORTHERN BORDER.

6 (a) PLAN.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after
the date of the enactment of this section, the Secretary, in consultation with appropriate interagency
partners, shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees a plan to establish travel corridors
at land-based border ports of entry to facilitate
cross-border travel at the northern border.

14 (2) NEGOTIATIONS.—In preparing the plan re15 quired under subsection (a), the Secretary, in con16 sultation with appropriate interagency partners,
17 shall seek to enter into negotiations with the appro18 priate counterparts of the Government of Canada to
19 establish—

20 (A) travel corridors at land-based border
21 ports of entry to facilitate cross-border travel at
22 the northern border based on guidance from the
23 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and
24 the Public Health Agency of Canada; and

25 (B) requirements relating to the docu-26 mentation needed for such cross-border travel.

1	(b) IMPLEMENTATION.—If the Secretary and the
2	Government of Canada enter into an agreement with re-
3	spect to establishing travel corridors pursuant to sub-
4	section $(a)(2)$, not later than 30 days after the date on
5	which such agreement is signed, the Secretary shall imple-
6	ment the plan required under subsection $(a)(1)$.
