I am requesting funding for Revere's Infrastructure Improvements Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Revere, MN, located at 400 Main St, Revere, MN 56166.

The funding would be used to modernize Revere's aging and undersized storm sewer system to improve drainage, reduce flooding, and provide more reliable, low-maintenance infrastructure. The work includes replacing deteriorated storm sewer components, installing new pipes, manholes, and catch basins, constructing an outfall to Pell Creek, and reconstructing streets, curbs, and sidewalks while updating system capacity to meet current design standards.

This project is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it addresses an undersized and deteriorating storm sewer system that can lead to flooding, property damage, and costly emergency repairs. By upgrading the system to meet current design standards and improving overall drainage, the project will provide more reliable, low-maintenance infrastructure and reduce long-term costs for the community. Investing in these improvements now helps protect public infrastructure, enhance safety, and avoid more expensive repairs in the future.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding is provided for purposes authorized by the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. 1383(c).
