I am requesting funding for the Green Lake and Spicer Water Tower Rehabilitation Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Glacial Lakes Sanitary Sewer and Water District, MN, located at 14403 138th Ave NE, Spicer, MN 56288.

The funding would be used to implement the proposed project, which will rehabilitate two aging water towers supplying drinking water and fire protection to residents of the City of Spicer, around Green Lake, and to tourists. The project is important to the local community because it will help ensure an adequate, safe water supply and essential fire protection resources.

The project is a sound use of taxpayer funds because it is rehabilitating the community's two water towers, protecting essential public infrastructure, ensuring safe and reliable drinking water, and preventing significantly higher future replacement costs. Rehabilitation of the two water towers is a strategic, cost-effective investment in resilient regional water infrastructure. Federal funding will ensure the continued delivery of safe drinking water, strengthen emergency preparedness, ensure regulatory compliance, and preserve critical assets that serve northern Kandiyohi County for decades to come.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding is provided for purposes authorized by the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. §300j-12.
